# KalmAid

## ► What is KalmAid for?

KalmAid is used for the management of nervous or anxious pets. KalmAid can also be used to manage long term behavioural problems.

## ► When does a dog or cat need KalmAid?

KalmAid should be used to manage anxious situations such as:

1. Separation anxiety
2. Strange surroundings – e.g kennels or minders
3. At weaning – when puppies are separated from their mothers
4. Environmental stresses, e.g lightning, fireworks
5. Travelling
6. Grooming
7. Behavioural Problems
8. Unwanted or unruly behaviour (longer term management)

## ► How does KalmAid work?

KalmAid contains L-Tryptophan which is an essential amino acid which affects production of serotonin. Serotonin has a calming and relaxing effect. L-theanine, another amino acid also has a calming effect. Thiamine (Vitamin B1) is added as deficiency has been associated with nervous disorders.

## ► How is KalmAid presented?

KalmAid is available as a 250ml caramel flavoured liquid with a measuring pump on the top of the bottle to help give the correct amount.

KalmAid is also available as tasty beef flavoured tablets in a handy tin container.

## ► How should KalmAid be given?

KalmAid can be poured over food as required. Use the handy pump on the top of the bottle for easy measuring. For an individual fear or anxiety event give as follows, preferably one hour before required effect.

Pet Weight	Kalm Aid Liquid*	Kalm Aid Tablets
<5kg	5ml	½ Tablet
5-10kg	10ml	1 Tablet
10kg-20kg	15ml	1½ Tablets
20kg - 30kg	20ml	2 Tablets
Over 30kg	25ml	2½ Tablets

\* 1 pump = 2.5ml

For dogs over 40kg, give a maximum of 20ml (3 Tabs) per day.

For long term management of behavioral problems give half the above amount daily.

KalmAid can be mixed with food. Safe for puppies and kittens, however maximum intake should be 0.5ml per kg or 0.25ml per lb. For short term use, give 1-2 hours before an 'anxious event'.

## ► How long should a dog or cat stay on KalmAid?

For anxious situations use as and when required. See the recommended intake table above. For long term management of behavioural problems continue the lower intake for up to 3 months.

## ► How soon should an effect be seen?

For immediate results give the recommended amount at least 1 hour before effect is required. As all pets are individuals, the requirements may vary

## ► Can KalmAid be given with other feeds or supplements?

Yes. KalmAid can be given in addition to any other supplements.

## ► How long does it last?

If given continuously, KalmAid liquid 250ml will last 50 days for a 10kg dog. A tin of 30 KalmAid tablets will last 30 days for the same dog if used daily.
