

The health of the skin and coat therefore depends on the type and properties of fatty acid available to them.

What's in OmegaAid?

Ingredients (per 10ml)	
Omega 3 (65% EPA+DHA)	1000mg
Omega 6	2000mg*
Vitamin A – Antioxidant	2666iu
Vitamin D – Antioxidant	666iu
Vitamin E – Antioxidant	27iu
*Evening primrose Oil	1000mg 9% GLA

Feeding recommendations

Weight	Amount
Up to 5kg	2.5ml daily (1 pump)
5-10kg	5ml daily (2 pumps)
10-20kg	7.5ml daily (3 pumps)
20-30kg	10ml daily (4 pumps)
Over 30kg	12.5-15ml daily (5/6 pumps)

After 4 weeks decrease daily intake by half.

► What is ArthriAid?



A nutritional food supplement to improve joint mobility.

What is a joint?

A joint is where two bones meet. It is made up of cartilage which 'sticks' the bones together and 'joint fluid', which prevents the bones from rubbing together. Joint mobility will be reduced when the balance between making new cartilage/'joint fluid' and its breakdown is upset. For example wear & tear on joints due to age, trauma and extra weight.

How ArthriAid works...

Glucosamine* provides the building blocks for the new cartilage and helps accelerate new cartilage formation, as well as protecting the existing cartilage. **Chondroitin*** helps prevent breakdown of joint cartilage. **MSM** is a natural sulphur compound which helps soothe tired joints and improves mobility. **Vitamin C** is an antioxidant and helps protect the joint cartilage. **Manganese** is an important mineral in the manufacture of new joint material.

***Note:** Gait Study 2005 proved that Glucosamine and Chondroitin in combination work synergistically and are much more effective for joint problems than the individual agents used on their own.

How to use ArthriAid

Weight	Recommended Amount
Up to 5kg	2.5ml daily (1 pump)
5-10kg	5ml daily (2 pumps)
10-20kg	10ml daily (4 pumps)
20-30kg	15ml daily (6 pumps)
Over 30kg	20ml daily (8 pumps)

For dogs over 40kg, give a maximum of 20ml per day. Each pump dispenses 2.5ml. After 14-21 days, intake can be reduced to the animals specific needs (usually can be reduced by half).

► What is KalmAid for?

KalmAid is used for the management of nervous or anxious pets. KalmAid can also be used to manage long-term behavioural problems.



When does a dog or cat need KalmAid?

KalmAid should be used to manage anxious situations such as:

- Separation anxiety
- Strange surroundings, eg: kennels or minders
- At weaning – when puppies are separated from their mothers
- Environmental stresses eg lightning, fireworks
- Travelling
- Grooming
- Behavioural problems
- Unwanted or unruly behaviour (longer term management)

How does KalmAid work?

KalmAid contains L-Tryptophan, an essential amino acid, which affects production of serotonin. Serotonin has a calming and relaxing effect.

L-theanine, another amino acid also has a calming effect. Thiamine (Vitamin B1) is added as deficiency has been associated with nervous disorders.

How is KalmAid presented?

KalmAid is available in a 250ml caramel flavoured liquid with a measuring pump on the top of the bottle, to help give the correct amount. KalmAid is also available as tasty beef flavoured tablets in a handy tin container.

How should KalmAid be given?

KalmAid can be poured over food as required. Use the handy pump on the top of the bottle for easy measuring. For an individual fear or anxiety event give as follows, preferably one hour before required effect.



Weight	KalmAid Liquid*	KalmAid Tablets
Up to 5kg	5ml daily (2 pumps)	½ tablet
5-10kg	10ml daily (4 pumps)	1 tablet
10-20kg	15ml daily (6 pumps)	1½ tablets
20-30kg	20ml daily (8 pumps)	2 tablets
Over 30kg	25ml daily (10 pumps)	2½ tablets

For dogs over 40kg, give a maximum of 20ml (3 tablets) per day.
* Each pump dispenses 2.5ml.

For long term management of behavioural problems give half the above amount daily.

KalmAid can be mixed with food. Safe for puppies and kittens, however maximum intake should be 0.5ml per kg or 0.25ml per lb. For short term use, give double the above administration 1-2 hours before an anxious event.

► What is OmegaAid?

A nutritional supplement to aid in the management of various skin conditions in cats and dogs. OmegaAid is designed to significantly increase the Omega 3 fatty acid intake.

How does OmegaAid work?

OmegaAid works by correcting any dietary fatty acid imbalances, ensuring the supply of the correct nutrients to maintain a healthy skin and coat. OmegaAid provides a supplemental source of Omega 3 and Omega 6 fatty acids plus Vitamins A, D and E, which are beneficial for the maintenance of healthy looking skin and coats in cats and dogs.

Essential fatty acids, called Omega 3 and Omega 6 fatty acids are needed by the body, just like vitamins. However, as the body cannot manufacture them they must be supplied by the diet. Fatty acids are major components of membranes such as skin, fur, nails and hair.
